Guide to the catalogue:

Totally Unreached = 0% Evangelical Christians

Unreached = <2% Evangelical Christians (in most cases there is a very low percentage of known evangelical Christians and quite possibly no gathering of believers. When the population of the people group is above 250,000 the chance there is a small church increases)

Some Progress = >2% Evangelical Christians

Reached = >5% Evangelical Christians

Bible no = No Bible translation exists not even New Testament.

[2018] = The last year the status of evangelical Christianity was checked to major sources

+ = Bridge - Some agency has a contact or special training for the field near that people group.
